
ORDER REMOVING DEFENDANT FROM
SEX OFFENDER REGISTRY

THIS CAUSE having come on to be heard upon Defendant's written motion to remove himself from the sex offender registry in the State of Florida and the same having been argued by the respective parties and considered by the Court it is hereby ordered that the Defendant's motion be and the same is hereby GRANTED. The Court makes the following findings of fact: (1) The Defendant was charged with an offense which is included in Florida Statute 943.0435 for removal; (2) The Defendant does not have any previous convictions for any sex offender crimes; (3) The Defendant was required to register as a sexual offender solely on the basis of the violation for which this motion addresses; (4) The Court finds that the Defendant, at the time of the offense, was not more than four years older than the victim in the above matter, who was fourteen years of age or older but not more than seventeen years of age at the time of the incident which formed the basis of the above prosecution and; (5) The conduct which formed the basis of the prosecution was neither forceful or coerced.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Florida Department of Law Enforcement remove the Defendant from the state sex offender registry based on the above prosecution and that the

Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles delete the sex offender registration requirements pursuant to Florida Statute 943.0435.
